Dear Club Officers,

The **Bicycle Access Council** is hosting the **11th Annual Pennsylvania Bike Club Conference**. Your club is invited to attend this event to learn and share your experience with other Pennsylvania bicycle clubs. The meeting will be held **Saturday, April 13** in **York, PA**.

The conference is meant to showcase *Best Practices* for clubs. This is a good opportunity for new club officers to ask questions to gain confidence and insight about their duties, and for established clubs to show leadership from their experiences.

The conference will begin at **9 a.m.** and include a full agenda of topics. The conference will end at **4 p.m.** and a local bicycle ride will be offered, weather permitting. A continental breakfast is included.

It is extremely important to have your attendance and input this year regarding several current issues and events affecting Pennsylvania bicyclists.

A full discussion will cover the new Bicycle Safety law, Act 3 of 2012 plus new legislative issues of interest to bike club members. And, as always, an opportunity to discuss general topics for bike clubs is welcome. Your club's most important issues can be added in advance or on the day of the conference during an open discussion.

The cost to attend is \$70, which includes lunch for two club representatives, snacks, refreshments and conference materials. A registration form is included. Registration information will also be listed on the Bicycle Access Council website.

Directions and detailed meeting information will be sent to a designated club representative once registration forms and fees have been received. Deadline for registration is April 8, 2013.

For those who wish to travel the night before and/or stay over in the area, a list of affordable hotels and restaurants close to the meeting location can be provided. A variety of local rides will be offered for those interested. York's Heritage Rail Trail is also nearby.
